	<p>ACCESSORIES: Hats, mittens, scarves, ties, socks, purses, wallets, backpacks, bags</p> <p>CLOTHING & SHOES: Men’s women’s, children’s</p> <p>ELECTRICAL ITEMS IN WORKING ORDER: Small toaster, microwave, and convection ovens, toasters, radios, irons, blenders, mixers, stereos, CD players speakers, DVD players, table lamps, floor lamps, fans, LCD or LED or plasma flat-screen televisions</p> <p>CHILDREN’S: games, puzzles,</p> <p>KITCHEN: Pots, pans, utensils, china cups, vases, dishes, cutlery, glassware, silverware, stemware</p> <p>KNICK-KNACKS: Jewelry, crafts, mugs, candles, pictures/frames, baskets, ornaments, arts & crafts items</p> <p>MEDIA: Hardback and paperback books, CDs, DVDs,</p> <p>SMALL FURNITURE: Chairs, bookcases, tables: dining, kitchen, coffee, end, computer, & nightstands</p> <p>TEXTILES: Bed/bath towels, sheets, blankets, pillows, curtains, tablecloths, placemats, cloth napkins</p> <p>ART-WORK: Watercolor and oil paintings, posters, wall-hangings</p> <p><i>Please Note: All donated items will be sorted into categories. Some will be used immediately; some may be saved to sell during a more appropriate season. Some items may be stored to sell at the Holiday Fair in Grandma’s or Grandpa’s Attic or Almost Antiques. Inappropriate items may be discarded or brought elsewhere.</i></p>	<p>UNDERWEAR: Underpants</p> <p>EXERCISE AND OUTDOOR: Bicycles, golf accessories, garden tools, sports equipment, exercise equipment, skis, archery equipment</p> <p>BEDS AND BEDDING PARTS: Mattresses, box springs, waterbeds, coil springs, etc.</p> <p>CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS: Lumber, pipes, floors, tubs, cabinets, carpet, doors, windows, etc. What about faucets, light fixtures, stained glass, windows hardware, decorative items?</p> <p>DAMAGED FURNITURE: Torn, soiled or in need of repair.</p> <p>FLAMMABLE PRODUCTS: Any items that operate on or contain fuel including gas cans, propane cylinders, barbecues, lawn mowers, weed trimmers, camp stoves, tiki torches, etc.</p> <p>HAZARDOUS MATERIALS: Batteries, paints, chemicals, cleaning products.</p> <p>INFANT & CHILD PRODUCTS: Car seats, cribs and related products (restricted by law), stuffed animals</p> <p>LARGE APPLIANCES: Refrigerators, dishwashers, furnaces, stoves, washing machines, humidifiers, dehumidifiers, etc.</p> <p>LARGE FURNITURE: Sofas, dressers, hutches, armoires, recliners, patio furniture, cabinets, entertainment centers, carpets</p> <p>HEALTH CARE ITEMS: Medical devices, foot baths, CPAP machines, humidifiers, dehumidifiers</p> <p>MARINE VESSELS AND ACCESSORIES: Boats, canoes, kayaks, paddles, lifejackets, etc.</p> <p>TELEVISIONS & COMPUTER MONITORS: Large televisions in cabinets, CRT “tube” TV’s & monitors</p> <p>WEAPONS: Firearms, explosives, ammunition, flares, hunting knives, pocketknives, bows, arrows</p> <p>MISCELLANEOUS: Magazines, records, tapes, video tapes, computer software, video games</p>
